GOOD SHEPHERD MINISTRIES NEEDS WORKERS: Good Shepherd Ministries, a Christian agency restoring people in recovery and reentry, is looking for volunteers to assist with the renovation of our newly purchased downtown Dayton building at 1115 E. 3rd St., near Keowee. We are racing hard to open a Thrift Store at this location before Christmas and we desperately need your help! Skilled or unskilled individuals or groups are welcome. Skilled tasks can change as we finish areas; we are currently hanging drywall, plastering, taping, painting, making an A/C wood deck, installing a drop ceiling, laying 1300 sq. ft. of linoleum, and setting up shelves. "Unskilled" work includes tasks such as sweeping, being a supply runner, wiping dust from wood work with oil soap, sorting/moving merchandise and stocking shelves for retail. Work is appropriate for adults or for children 14 and over accompanied by an adult. Power tool use is limited to adults. Work can be scheduled Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and Saturday 10:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Evening hours are available based on the needs of the volunteer. We welcome organizations such as Knights of Columbus and will be flexible in scheduling to meet group needs.
