## EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM

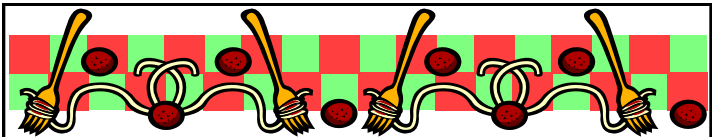
