*For the Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time  
(February 23, 2014)*

"So be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect." How do you define perfection? Is your idea of perfection linked to the idea of measuring up to some standard? In our 21<sup>st</sup> Century society, do our standards include God's vision of the world? Or are we simply locked into the world's vision of perfection? **AMERICAN MATHEMATICS COMPETITION 8 SCHOOL RESULTS:** St. Luke School eighth grade students recently participated in the 2013-2014 American Mathematics Competition given at Carroll High School in November. The AMC 8 is a challenging contest and students are to be commended for their work. There were over one hundred and fifteen students from ten area Catholic grade schools tested at Carroll. The average score was 8.17. Over 150,000 students from over 2,400 schools worldwide participated with an average score of 10.69. Michael Price was the second highest scoring student at Carroll High School with a score of 16. Alexander Mayer received 10<sup>th</sup> place recognition with a score of 12.
