Christian unity requires "much prayer, humility, reflection and continual conversion," he said. Let the Lord's name be proclaimed, not to shut people out, but "to open the heart to love which unites and enriches....Let's pray that the Lord grants unity to Christians, living differences as a richness; seeing the other as a brother to welcome with love."**
