### THE BOOK OF NAMES OF THE DEAD

November is the time of harvest and the beginning of the earth's winter sleep. For centuries the Church has observed this month as a special time to pray for our dead. Again this year the parish **Book of Names of the Dead** will be at the Baptismal Font on November 1<sup>st</sup>. Parishioners are invited to write the names of their deceased family members in the book. This book serves as a reminder and invitation to pray for the dead. At each Mass during the month of November we will pray for those whose names are inscribed in the book. Names of parishioners who were buried from St. Luke Church during the past year have already been placed in the book. You may enter names in the book anytime throughout the month of November.

### FAMILY REMEMBRANCE BINDER FOR OUR DEARLY DEPARTED

Our parish also is creating a Family Remembrance Binder with special homemade memorial pages. You are invited to participate in this beautiful tradition by creating your own memorial page. You may pick up envelopes at the Jansen Center that contain the information/material you need.

### ALL SOULS EVENING PRAYER

Since the 13<sup>th</sup> century, Catholics have set apart November 2<sup>nd</sup> as a day of prayerful remembrance for all the faithful departed. On Sunday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will celebrate All Souls Day with a special Evening Prayer for the Dead starting at 7:00 p.m. in the Church. We will remember all parishioners who have died in the past year as well as all our beloved dead. Join us as we pray and help us celebrate the promise of resurrection and eternal life which Christ has given to us.

### CANDLES FOR ALL SOULS EVENING PRAYER

At the All Souls Evening Prayer we will light candles for those who have died in the past year. Family members may take these candles home after the service. We already have candles set aside for all parishioners whose funerals were held at our parish in the past year.
