**SCHOOL HAPPENINGS:** Following is what has been happening in the month of March/April at St. Luke School.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade- Mrs. Brooks:** In Religion, students completed their study on the Works of Mercy. Students studied the Underground Railroad in Reading and Computer class. This tied in with writing their "Lighting the Way to Freedom" stories.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade- Mrs. Carter:** The 4<sup>th</sup> graders in Mrs. Carter's class just finished their unit on simple machines. They had fun making a lever and testing the placement of the fulcrum to lift a load.

**Junior High Math:** Pre-Algebra students took a look outside near the playground to look for right angles. They learned how to apply the Pythagorean Theory for real world solutions. Algebra students started a unit on Quadratic Equations and learning to graph them. Students found examples in Golf and Basketball where they could apply quadratic equation to figure out if the basketball would make it in the hoop or if the golf ball will be a hole in one. In 8<sup>th</sup> grade math, students created a large graph "paper" of our floor and used their desks and chairs in a study on Transformations. In 7<sup>th</sup> grade math, students began a unit about Probability and Statistics with the roll of a dice.

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade Religion:** Students finished their Confirmation interviews and received a small presentation on the Ambry and the Chrism by Father Terry.
