CUSTODIAN/MAINTENANCE VACANCY TO BE FILLED:

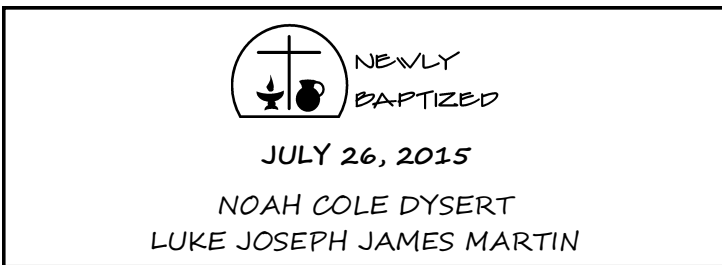
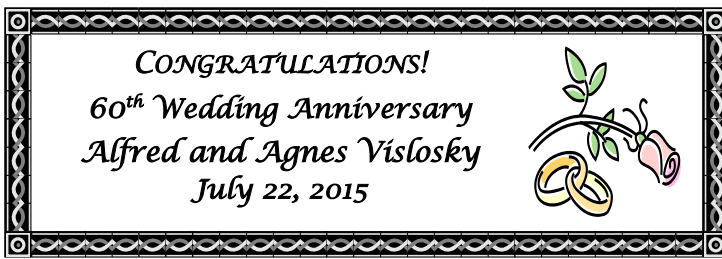
