Good News!** Last Sunday and this one, too, Jesus declares: “Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.” In Luke’s Gospel, Jesus’ first compassionate act is making wine for the Cana wedding feast. His first public words focus on care for the poor, the captive, the blind, and the oppressed (last Sunday). Gracious words! Amazing words (this Sunday)! 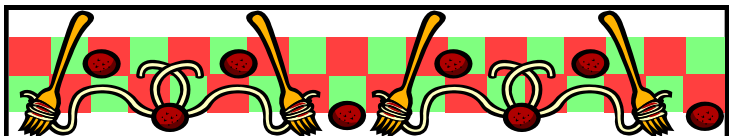
