DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE OPPORTUNITIES—JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY: Lisa Donigian, a Saint Luke parishioner, is inviting other parishioners to join her in a personal day of pilgrimage to, any one or all three, designated mid-Ohio diocesan Jubilee Year sites. Pope Francis encouraged each diocese to include a **Holy Door** devotion to which pilgrims can journey during the Jubilee Year of Mercy. A **Holy Door of Mercy** represents the compassion, love, mercy, and consolation of God working in our lives. A personal pilgrimage is to open (like a door) an individual to experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope, and to enhance a spiritual renewal in God's grace.
