**CANS FOR THE HUNGRY**—Next weekend, **July 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>**, your donations of **CANS** of common vegetables (peas, corn, green beans, carrots) and fruits (peaches, pears, applesauce, mandarin oranges) are welcome additions to the nutritional staples of our hungry neighbors. This collection happens on the first full weekend of every month before and after Masses. Cans are collected in Kramer Hall. Thank you for your willingness to help people in need!



**COLLECTION DURING JULY—DAYTON RIGHT TO LIFE** is in need of help for their Emergency Stork's Nest Baby Pantry. The Stork's Nest offers free assistance to parents who find themselves unable to provide basic needs for their children. Through this outreach Dayton Right to Life is able to provide diapers, formula, baby food and gently used clothing to needy families. Clients are permitted to visit the pantry every three months to ensure their child has enough supplies to hold them over to their next paycheck. The ability of the Stork's Nest to supply needed items is being stretched to the limit. Items needed include Similac Advance (powder and liquid), bath towels for infants, baby wash, shampoo, lotion, size 5 diapers, pull-ups 4T and 5T, toddler underwear, toddler pajamas, cereal, sippy cups, newborn diapers, toddler socks, and boy toddler shorts (3T and 4T). You can help by donating some of these items as you are able. Please bring your items to Kramer Hall during July and place them on the table near the nursery.

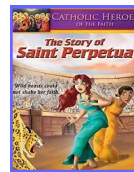
