SOUTH PROPERTY BORDER - Partial Clearing and Landscaping: Parishioners will easily observe the overgrowth clearing that has occurred towards the eastern end (Bishop Ford Hall) of the parish's south border. The several feet deep of overgrowth cleared is situated on our property-line-side with Primrose School. Landscaping efforts will extend the current south border guardrail, level the ground on our side of the property line, and add plantings at intervals to enhance the section's appearance. When pleased with the development, the overgrowth area towards the western end (Fairfield Road) of the south border will be cleared and the appearance duplicated. Temporary caution is recommended when driving along the cleared area.

We will prepare and serve the evening meal for the Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN) shelter in Xenia. At the present time there are in residence 6 adults and 8 children, all eating table food age. The count can change as we get closer to the actual date. We will prepare a meat dish, vegetable, salad (green or fruit), dinner rolls and desert (cookies, brownies or other finger food) and some punch (powder is fine) to drink. COLLECTION DURING JULY—DAYTON RIGHT TO LIFE is in need of help for their Emergency Stork's Nest Baby Pantry. The Stork's Nest offers free assistance to parents who find themselves unable to provide basic needs for their children. Through this outreach Dayton Right to Life is able to provide diapers, formula, baby food and gently used clothing to needy families. Clients are permitted to visit the pantry every three months to ensure they have enough supplies to hold them over to their next paycheck. The ability of the Stork's Nest to supply needed items is being stretched to the limit. You can help by donating some of these items. Please bring your items to Kramer Hall during July and place them on the table near the nursery.
