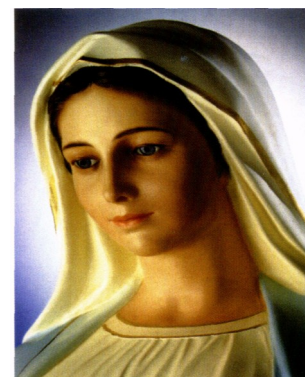


Come pray with others to Mary, Our Mother for:

5 and up. Nursery services will be available for ages 0-4.

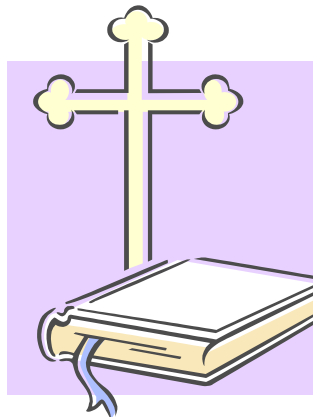

# FOOD DRIVE 2014-2015

This year, our collected items will be given to The FISH Pantry in Beavercreek. The pantry is located IN Beavercreek and serves the needy in our area. The need for necessities is growing and the pantry's supplies of many items are often depleted. Please see the schedule below with targeted items to donate. While these specific items are mentioned, ALL DONATIONS ARE GREATLY APPRECIATED! Please donate what and when you are able. We always have a basket in the school lobby to hold food items, so feel free to send or bring in items anytime. We will collect all month and the items will be picked up on the Friday of our collection week. **Each month, as we remind our families of the food drive, we will communicate any special immediate needs required by the pantry.**

## **October 13-17**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed macaroni & cheese, canned meats, canned fruits, boxed rice/potatoes

## **November 10-21**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed macaroni & cheese, boxed stuffing, gravy, canned vegetables, meats, and fruit

## **December 8-12**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: cookie and cake mixes, baby food, drinks, peanut butter and jelly

## **January 12-16**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed macaroni & cheese, boxed potatoes and rice, canned meats and proteins, boxed cereal

## **February 17-20**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed macaroni & cheese, canned meats & fruits, boxed cereal & snacks

## **March 16-20**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed macaroni & cheese, canned fruits, pasta and meats

## **April 20-24**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed mac & cheese, packaged sides, canned meats, cereal

## **May 11-15**

Non-perishable items ESPECIALLY: boxed mac & cheese, paper products, proteins,
